CHECK IN / MEASURING:

Check in and measuring, starts at 7:15 on Saturday. Please make sure you have your dog's AAC ID card with you. First dog on the line 8:00 am. Please send a picture of your dog's height card if you have not done so for previous trials.

EQUIPMENT FAMILIARIZATION:

For Starters Dogs while happen later in the day but prior to the first starters dog.

CRATING:

Crating space is available, outdoor only.

MOVE-UPS:

Same day move-ups are allowed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are familiar with AAC rules and regulations, including but not limited to the following:

This event is open to all dogs at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the MC. No leads, collars, except flat collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time. No toys or food on course during familiarization. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show grounds and no refund of fees paid will be made. Exhibitors must keep crating and exercise areas clean. Please pick up after yourself and your dogs.

There will be no refund after the closing date for dogs that are withdrawn except for sick/injured dogs if we are provided with a vet's certificate.

Bitches in season (BIS) may participate but we must be notified ahead of time. Handlers must limit movement of the BIS and only use the designated relief area. A BIS must wear panties at all times on the property, including during the run, except while in the designated relief area. The BIS will run at the end of each class and the handler must provide a mat for the start line. Competitors who choose not to compete because there is a BIS will be offered credit for the next trial.

Ribbons will be awarded for first through fourth place and for all qualifying runs. Titling ribbons will also be awarded to dogs that earn a title.

CONFIRMATION:

Confirmation will be e-mailed to you. If you do not receive a confirmation email 1 week prior to the trial date, or if there are errors, please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. This will help avoid delays on the day of the trial.

All entrants are requested to volunteer as much as possible. Please let the trial secretary know ahead of the trial if you are

able to help with course building. Other volunteer jobs include gating, timing, scribing, leash running and ring crew (changing bar heights). Please sign up for jobs ahead of time on the sign-up sheet so we do not have to waste time looking for help before each run. As we all know, the more help we have the faster the trial moves along.

Agility Association of Canada General Agreement

I/We, the undersigned, agree that the Host Club has the right to refuse my entry for causes, which the organizing committee shall deem to be sufficient.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the event and the opportunity to have the dog participate or, be judged.

I/We agree to hold the organizing committee, the organization which it represents including its members, officers and directors, the Agility Association of Canada, sponsors of the event, owner of the premises upon which the event is being held and their employees, harmless from any claims for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any persons or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the event premises or grounds or near entrances thereto, and I/We personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim.
